

Demolition permits sought for Jasper Avenue corner

Plans are in the works to reshape a key corner of Jasper Avenue.

EDMONTON — Applications for demolition permits have been filed by Ledcor Construction Ltd. with the City of Edmonton to level the former Bank of Montreal building and the old Odeon theatre, which most recently functioned as the New City nightclub.

The properties were acquired four years ago by a division of General Electric, GE Real Estate.

GE has been working with real estate firm [Avison Young](#), architecture firm Dialog and Ledcor on a proposed redevelopment of the site into a mix of office and retail space.

Representatives of those companies declined to comment on plans Friday.
